History

In 1982, John Biver was in the early days of his career as a civil engineer at a Midwest firm. He and his business partner decided to buy one of IBM's first PCs only months after its release. They quickly realized that the computer had no engineering software to help them with their jobs, so the pair decided to build their own.

The duo started writing software and decided to exhibit at that year's Iowa County Engineers' Conference, where their goal was to make the lives and jobs of engineers more efficient. In an inaugural use of their software, they analyzed a large State Highway project and discovered a problem that saved their client in excess of \$100,000. Then, in the following year of 1983, John and his partner officially launch Eagle Point Software: an innovative e-learning platform designed by engineers for engineers.

Over the next decade, Eagle Point grew quickly and was recognized as one of the nation's top fastest-growing, privately held companies. The company was featured in Forbes Magazine, was ranked three times on the INC. 500 list, and received numerous other honors and awards. In the 1990s, Eagle Point launched an IPO and became a publicly-traded company.

In 2001, Eagle Point again became a private enterprise to return the company's focus to its core values: serving their customers with a personal connection, hard work, and integrity. By the end of the decade, the company identified engineers' and architects' need to improve their efficiency and worked to develop a solution. Eagle Point developed the inaugural version of Pinnacle Series, a unique platform with AEC software training content created by industry experts. In the following years, Pinnacle Series evolved into the leading Autodesk e-learning system for the AEC space.

Recently, Eagle Point set out to help the AEC industry adopt new technologies and concepts. As such, Pinnacle Series began featuring content beyond the Autodesk portfolio for AEC organizations, including the construction market that has entered into a digital transformation.
